If you would like to visit our research facilities and join a guided tour, you are kindly asked to apply through our dedicated online booking form. Once you submit all the required information, you will receive a notification with the booking details and the guidelines to follow prior to your visit. If your preferred date is fully booked, you will be notified automatically. Should your confirmed visit need to be cancelled - for reasons such as weather conditions or other unforeseen circumstances - you will be contacted and offered alternative dates.

On the day of the tour, it is important to arrive at least 10 minutes beforehand. Visitors will be welcomed and guided by a dedicated officer or team. During the tour, you will have the opportunity to visit several of our research facilities, learn about our ongoing research and the various species we work with, and meet our dedicated staff. The tour typically lasts around 45 minutes.
